Annex I

Terms and Conditions for Medical Insurance:

- A. Medical Insurance means insurance service to be provided by Insurance Company to the Saving/Social Security Savings Account holders of Bank to provide reimbursement of medical expenses up to NPR. 100,000 (One Hundred Thousand Only) incurred in all hospitals and clinics in Nepal, listed 70 hospitals in India and all hospitals of Thailand and Singapore.
- B. In the case of joint account holders, all joint holders shall be eligible to claim medical insurance facility. However, it shall be on first come first serve basis and the total eligible amount will be same as single account procedure.
- C. The account holder shall be eligible for the facility from the day one of account opening, however there should be sufficient deposit balance as mentioned in point "H" below.
- D. The maximum liability under medical insurance facility for one-year period is NPR. 100,000 [Hospitalization NPR. 80,000 and Out Patient Department (OPD) NPR. 20,000].
- E. The maximum limit for Hospitalization and OPD treatment shall be applicable for 3 times during the policy period but not exceeding NPR. 80,000 and NPR. 20,000 respectively, i.e. 3 OPD claims and 3 Hospitalization claims can be claimed in One Financial Year.
- F. Maximum Ambulance Charge Limit of NPR10,000 that is followed by hospitalization will be applicable.
- G. Delivery case (both normal and C-section) is also covered for Government/Semi-Government Hospital treatment with limit of NPR. 10,000 or actual bill, whichever is lower. This facility shall be provided for 1 time in a year for Wonder Women Saving Account holders only.
- H. Claim payable will be 25% of weighted average annual balance (last 365 days from Hospitalization/OPD treatment date) of deposit account or up to NPR 100,000 (NPR 80,000 for Hospitalization and up to 20,000 for OPD) or Hospital Bill, whichever is lower. In case of recently opened accounts also, 365 days average balance would be considered and the balance for days before the opened date shall be considered as Zero.
- I. Day Care surgery will be provided for the 150 surgeries as per below table (*Day Care Surgeries*).
- J. The insured must be hospitalized for at least 24 hours or 1 Night to lodge any claim for hospitalization. However, in the case of Day Care Surgery this condition is not applicable i.e. listed 150 Day Care Surgeries can be claimed under Hospitalization Limit of NPR 80,000.
- K. The details of the customer will be provided to Insurance company at the time of claim reimbursement process.
- L. Coverage of diabetes, hypertension and thyroid before diagnosis is to be covered. Once it is diagnosed no further treatment shall be covered. Under this policy and no reimbursement shall be given.
- M. Minimum claim amount is NPR 2,500 i.e., only medical claims of and above NPR 2,500 shall be processed. There is a limit of 3 OPD claims and 3 Hospitalization claims in a year which starts from first Shrawan till Ashad End.

Annex II

Exclusions

- a. Medical claim where amount is less than NPR 2,500 under domiciliary treatment (OPD treatment).
- b. Insanity, Intentional self-injury or attempted suicide, dissipation or drunkenness, use of intoxicating drugs or liquors.
- c. Eye test, optical and dental treatment, artificial teeth and hearing aid.
- d. Beauty treatment or beauty cream.
- e. Miscarriage or abortion or pregnancy. However, delivery case shall be eligible.
- f. Expenses incurred in Homeopathy other than Jaundice based.
- g. Ayurvedic Treatment Prescribed by other than registered Ayurvedic Medical Practitioner as per Nepalese law.
- h. Expenses incurred due to war invasion act or while life assured is serving as member of any defense police or national security force except group accident.
- i. Any injury or sickness arising out of Riot, Strike, malicious act, sabotage and terrorism.
- j. Venereal or sexually transmitted disease, AIDS or AIDs related complex and / or any illness arising as complications from these conditions.
- k. Routine checkup of Hypertension, Diabetes and Thyroid. However, claim before diagnosis is eligible.
- l. Expenses for any type of liquid vitamin other than as may be necessitated due to an accident.
- m. Coverage of any type of vaccination.
- n. Pre- existing disease and pre-existing critical illness.
